

GET THE FACTS **on PAYROLL TAX (Income Tax)**

**Current income tax rate for
Mayfield Heights is 1%**

**Proposed income tax
increase of .5%**
(Will still be among the lowest in
Cuyahoga County at 1.5%)

Who Will Be Affected

**92% of the increase will be paid by people who live outside
of the City of Mayfield Heights.**

Income tax applies to **PAYROLL TAX** for people who work
in the City of Mayfield Heights. If you do not work in the city,
you are not affected by the income tax increase.

**72% of residents will either see no increase or an actual
reduction in their taxes.**

A 100% income tax credit of the first 1.5% in income tax a
resident pays to another community will be given.

Retirement and investment income are exempt from the tax.

What Does the City Gain

The income tax increase will provide an additional \$5 million
a year in funding for our community – giving us much needed
resources to:

- Strengthen our city's safety forces
- Improve our parks and our recreation (ex: Dragga Pool)
- Increase the city's Road Program (repairs to city streets)
- Replace vehicles and equipment (ex: replace 20+ yr. old fire engine)
- Make long overdue investments to strengthen our city,
including **revitalizing the Mayland Shopping Center.**
