#### **REPORT OF RECREATION DIRECTOR**

Mr. Ward reported that April 6<sup>th</sup> is the initial sign up date for summer camps, pool passes, and swimming lessons. Registration kick-off for these summer programs will be held at the DeJohn Community Center starting at 8am until 10:30am.

April 7<sup>th</sup> is our annual Pancake Breakfast from 8:30-12:30. We hope to see everyone there for a great time.

Breakfast with the Bunny is to take place on April 13<sup>th</sup>. Currently, 60 kids and 60+ adults are registered. The numbers are growing and top off at 70 kids and 70 adults.

The Young at Heart, Taste of the Islands, had 110 attendees. Seniors enjoyed island foods, desserts and games. The event was a success and had positive feedback.

Much discussion of our park facilities (Issue 48) took place pertaining to the city pool. The pools age and condition are a major concern for the Recreation Department. The pools condition continues to deteriorate the 61 year old facility. We will survey our residents to determine what our next step should be.

#### **REPORT OF COUNCIL MEMBER DON MANNO**

Mr. Manno discussed the council meeting on BZA variances for fences and sheds. Advertising for concrete and asphalt bids are to go out. He also mentioned possibly bringing back the city sidewalk program. Another meeting will be scheduled to discuss this in more detail.



**NEW BUSINESS**


