Mr. Manno reported that Council approved various items for BZA, legislation for the Park Project, voted on the contracts for Police and Fire Departments. The contract did not pass due to the language in regard to raises. The Council felt they needed more information; however, after 30 days the contract will most likely pass on its own. Council also declined all the sidewalk bids and will have to be resubmitted.

He addressed the issues that Kimble has been having in regard to staffing issues that has resulted in issues with trash collection. These issues include new hires need to be trained and hold a CDL. They are working on all of this and hope to have new staff on the roads soon.
