REPORT OF MAYOR

Mayor DiCicco addressed that May 20th - August 2nd East of SOM Center Road to River Road will be closed for repairs. Please plan travels accordingly.

Arbor Day on April 26th was a success. A cherry tree was planted in honor of Lisa Benedetti who served in the cities finance department for 30+ years.

May 4th was our annual shred day. We collected over 12,000 lbs. of paper products and nearly 4,000 lbs. of electronics. Much hazardous waste was also collected and transported to the County for proper disposal.

The police department had a new patrol officer sworn in May 21st. Officer Seth Klco joined our police force. He is a 6 year State Highway Patrol officer veteran. We are happy to have Seth serve our city.

As of June 17th through July 15th Cedar Road to the 271 bridge will have work being done. Please note possible delays.

REPORT OF RECREATION DIRECTOR

Mr. Ward reported that we are still narrowing down the Unity Days parade marshal. We have not finalized the parade marshal, but will be doing so any time now. WWII Vets, school band members, Wildcat football players and cheerleaders will all be part of this event. Volunteer schedules for the tents and activities have been divided up between park and recreation council members.

Some of our 2019 summer events include the city park movie night. The first movie night has been moved from Oakville Park to the main city park. The annual car show is to take place July 25th and the Mayor's Golf Outing is July 26th at Fowler's Mill golf course. Our First Responders night will take place on Saturday, August 3rd. The activities include a 300ft zip line, inflatables, as well as a D.J. in the park. We should have a nice turnout for all the summer activities and events.

An independent third party survey for the city will be going out to the community on various recreations needs and concerns. Our city pool is 62+ years old and has had many problems in recent years. The Impact Group will be conducting a survey for our community. Feedback is important and crucial so the city knows what its residents want facilities wise. It is a good planning tool.


